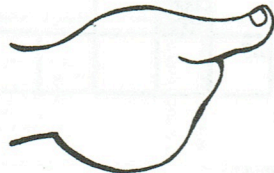
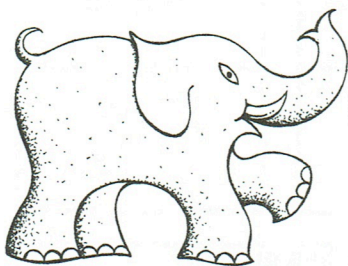


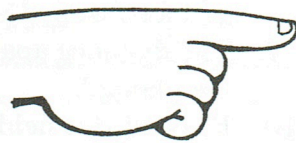
HOM PIM PAH

This is used to choose the order people will play a game when there are more than two players. When there are only two players, play *Sut*.

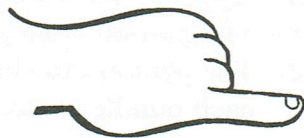
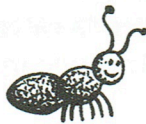
- ◆ Stand in a circle.
- ◆ Hold your right hand in front of you, palm down.
- ◆ Turn your hand, facing palm up then palm down, in time while saying 'Hom Pi Lah, Hom Pim Pah!'
- ◆ When you say the word 'Pah!' choose palm up or palm down.
- ◆ If all players' hands are the same, play again.
- ◆ Play until only one player is different. This player goes first.
- ◆ Other players continue playing *Hom Pim Pah* until there are only two players.
- ◆ Then they play *Sut* to see who goes last.

You may recognise this game as 'rock, paper, scissors'.

- ◆ Face each other and make a fist.
- ◆ Bring the fist down three times, on the count of *satu, dua, tiga* (one, two, three).
- ◆ On *tiga*, make a *gajah* (elephant), *orang* (person) or *semut* (ant) with your hand. (See pictures.)
- ◆ *Gajah* beats *orang*, because *orang* can be trampled by the *gajah*.
- ◆ *Orang* beats *semut*, because *orang* can step on the *semut* and squash it.
- ◆ *Semut* beats *gajah*, because it can crawl in the *gajah's* ear and tickle it to drive it crazy.
- ◆ If both hands are the same, play again.
